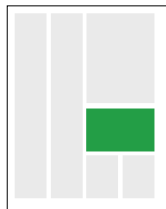
Half Page Horizontal

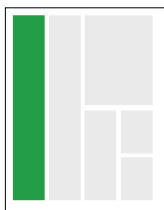
1/8 Page Vertical
Strip 4.165 x 11.75 cm



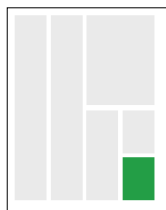
Half Page Vertical

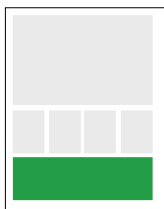

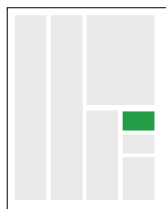

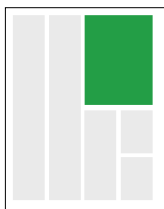
